### I-25 Exit Ramp Changes

Tony Stewart, Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) Project Engineer, shared the following information with JPUN:

- The southbound 23rd Ave. detour exit ramp will be in place until the new exit is completed Spring '07;
- Alcott St. north of 23rd Ave. is permanently closed. A cul-de-sac will be created;
- One more light pole will be installed at 23rd Ave. & exit ramps. Within 3-4 months the signals at this intersection will be activated;
- All changes to Speer exit ramps and interchange signals will not be completed until May '07.
