## **Goal: Improve Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety**

### **Problems:**

- Bridge Railings damaged, rusted and falling off
- No sidewalk ever built on the Bridge Approaches
- Pedestrian & Bicycle Signage below City standards
- Poor maintenance and aesthetics at I-25 & Water St.

### **Solutions:**

- CDOT replaces bridge railings with pedestrian screen
- Denver's Disability Rights Office installed ADA Ramps
- JPUN to install ADA compliant granite fine path
- Denver Public Works to install signs and bike lanes
- City, State, JPUN & Venues to improve "gateway"

### **Resource Needed for Pedestrian Path:**

- 15 Tons granite fines
- Bobcat to excavate bed and move granite fines
- Dump truck to haul the fines to location
- Flagmen for traffic control
- Neighborhood volunteers with picks and shovels
