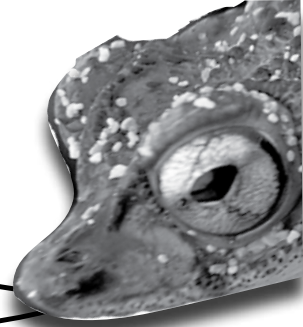

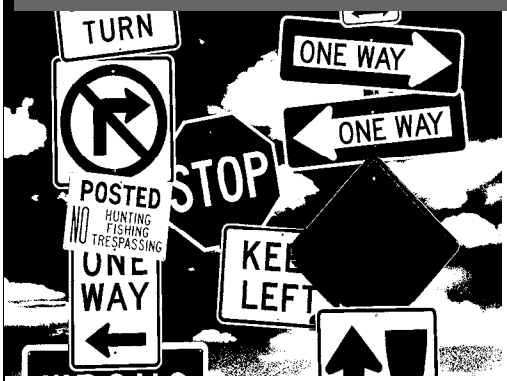
## 100,000 dollars on the way to fix up Jefferson Park. How do you want it spent?

Denver Youth Curfew Ordinance in Effect: Stepped up enforcement of Denver's citywide youth curfew is now in effect. On Fri., Sat. and Sun. nights, youth will be ticketed and taken to SafeNite Curfew Site located at the District One Police Station, 1311 W.46th Ave. Youth 17 years old and younger must be off the street on Friday and Saturday nights from midnight through 5:00 A.M., and Sunday through Thursday from 11:00 P.M. through 5:00 A.M. Youths and/or parent(s)/guardians may be cited. Exceptions: Youth in motor vehicle involved in interstate travel. Youth going to/from work without any detour or stop. Youth accompanied by parent/guardian or other adult with signed note by parent/guardian dated specifically for that night. For additional information call 3-1-1.

Safety Tip of the Month, Telephone Safety:

Daily Telephone Security

Never give personal information (name, age, address, etc.) to a stranger on the telephone;

Never let a stranger on the telephone know when you will or will not be home;

Never let a stranger on the telephone know you are home alone; instruct babysitters never to tell anyone who calls that they are home alone with children;

Teach children old enough to be left alone never to tell a stranger who telephones that parents are gone. Teach them to say, "My mom can't come to the phone now. May I take a message?" Credit card/Social Security #, etc. Do not give out a credit card or social security number to someone who you do not know or whom you did not call.
